You must also prove that you are in school, graduated from high school, have a GED, or have been honorably discharged from the military.	Examples: • Diploma • GED certificate • Report cards (every semester/quarter) • School transcripts (every semester/quarter)
You have <b>not been convicted</b> of a felony, significant misdemeanor, or three or more other misdemeanors and od not otherwise pose a threat to national security or public safety.	<ul> <li>If you have every been arrested:</li> <li>You almost always have to disclose this information, but we recommend speaking to the clinic about where you need to disclose the information and what documents you should submit.</li> </ul>
